**Subject Area: World Languages**  
**Course Name: French IV (G&T)**

**Summary:** French IV is an Honors course with weighted grades. Admission to the course will be based upon the student's receiving a final grade of at least "C" in French III and upon teacher recommendation. Advanced composition and a study of the finer points of French grammar are stressed. Intensive vocabulary building will be continued. Reading and conversation will cover both historic and current examples of French and Francophonic literature. French and Francophonic culture is emphasized as well. Students who choose may enroll in the High School Plus Program with Camden County College. These students will receive three college credits for a final grade of "B" or better.
